The CFC is the only authorized charitable solicitation permitted in the federal workplace. It provides employees the option of directing money to charities of their choice through payroll deduction or one-time contribution.

A partnership with health and human service agencies is the cornerstone of the CFC. Our purpose is to provide a convenient vehicle federal employees can use for contributing to these agencies.
